“Our whole school attendance for 2021/22 was 95.77% and excellent rates of punctuality (0.38% latest) We recognise that there needs to be further improvements in our attendance, particularly in our persistent absence which was 8.9% for 2021/22. This has increased by 2% due to families taking unauthorised holidays, which were booked before the pandemic and families were ‘catching up’ on their holidays previously booked. A new attendance strategy is being implemented in autumn 2022 and we continue to concentrate on rapidly improving the attendance of our disadvantaged children.”
