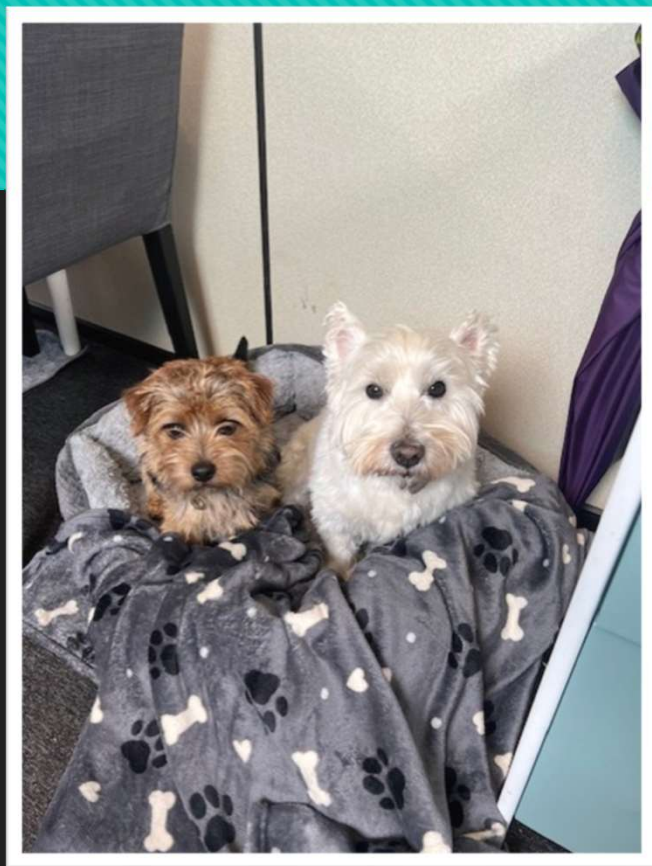




Arlo & Watson – The Dog Mentors

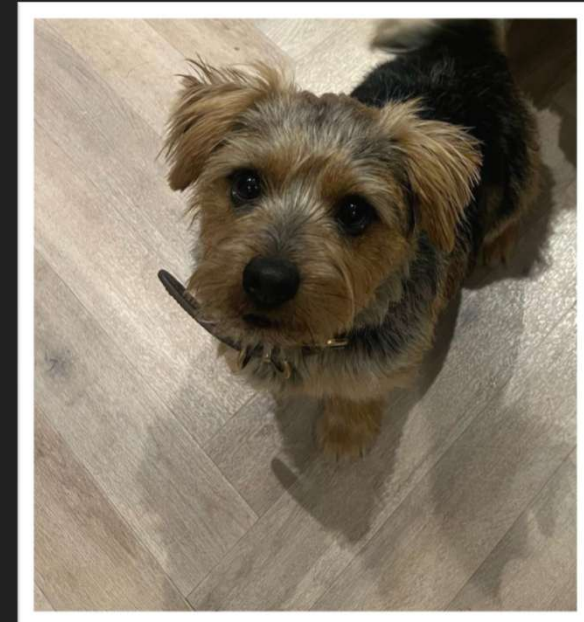
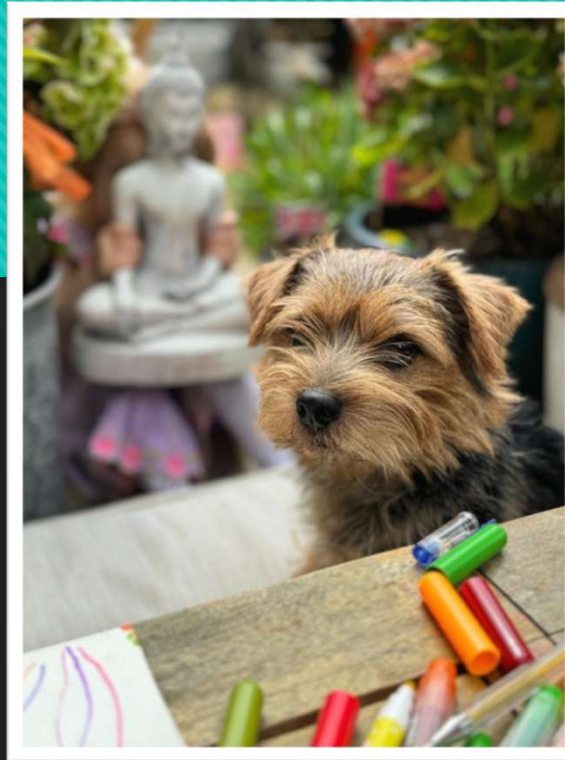


All About Arlo & Watson

- Being picked up (only an adult Arlo trusts can do this)

What Watson doesn't like...

- Loud sudden noises
- Big crowded
- Rough hands
- Being picked up (only an adult Watson trusts can do this)

Why do Arlo and Watson come to school?

- Communication – verbal and non-verbal communication
- Confidence
- Develop our empathy and ability to care for others
- Focus and concentration
- Wellbeing – all of our Crossflatts Family



What will we do to keep ourselves and Arlo and Watson safe?

- We ALWAYS ask the grown up with Arlo/Watson if we can stroke him (there will NEVER be more than 2 hands on Arlo/Watson at a time)
- We MUST approach Arlo/Watson calmly and quietly
- We use quiet talking voices around Arlo /Watson
- We ALWAYS walk when we are around Arlo /Watson
- We NEVER feed Arlo/Watson or eat around them, unless an adult with the dog says it is okay to give them a treat.
- We ALWAYS make sure that the floors are clear
