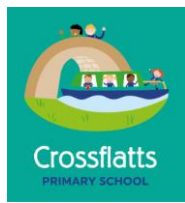

Friends of Crossflatts

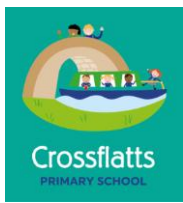
