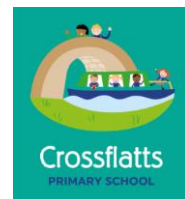

Hi Everyone,

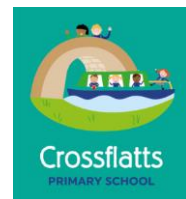
What is going on with the weather this week? It is so cold! I am really hopeful for some warmer days over the bank holiday for everyone to be able to go outside and enjoy some sunshine.



A few weeks ago we sent out the parent survey for our school. We had 88 responses, thank you to everyone who submitted their survey, it is really useful to receive feedback so we can continue to make our school the best it can possibly be for the children we serve. Here is a summary of the results:

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I was delighted to read of the **88 respondents that 94% (81) would recommend our school** to a friend. I would only recommend a school that I trust and have confidence in to my friends. We are a school, who never stands still and are always striving to be the best we can be.

I do want to remind families, if you have any concerns around friendships or bullying, please be assured, these are taken extremely seriously and we will respond as soon as we are aware of any concern. We work very hard in our school to make sure all of the children feel safe all of the time, we also teach our children the difference between falling out with a friend and bullying. In school we use the simple acronym **STOP which means bullying is SEVERAL TIMES ON PURPOSE. STOP- start telling other people.** Our children are very able to explain what to do if they feel they are being bullied and know we will make it stop.

Should you ever wish to discuss any concerns please do contact me, Mrs Petrie or Mrs Dobson. I am a very visible headteacher and on the gate every morning and afternoon. You are more than welcome to give me or my deputy headteachers, a call or an email and we will listen and respond as quickly as possible. We are in genuine partnership with our families and we are working to the same goal as our families. That our children are safe, happy and can achieve.

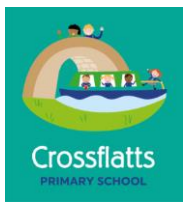
We have released our exciting club timetable for the summer term- see below- there are still a few places left so please do contact the office if you wish for your child to take part.
