Hi Everyone,

Another very busy week in school this week. We have welcomed some visiting teachers from Malawi in Africa this week, who have come over to England to observe the British education system in practise. They were so complementary of our school curriculum and our children's impeccable behaviour.



We have had several children experiencing a sickness bug over the past week, particularly in Year 2. We have deep cleaned the classrooms and are increasing sanitising and handwashing in school. Please can you reiterate the importance of regular hand washing to your child. If your child does experience any vomiting, it is school policy for your child to remain at home for 48 hours from the last episode of sickness, in order to stop the spread of the bug.

Tomorrow, **23rd of June**, our Year 6 children will be holding their annual Prom fund raiser stalls where the rest of school are invited to visit their stalls which sell-baked goods, drinks, games to play, toys and books to buy. If the children could bring a donation of £2 in an envelope with their name labelled and give their envelope to their class teacher they will be issued with tokens to spend on the day.


