

Friends of Crossflatts would like to announce that we raised an incredible £6,826.58 at Rose Day last week. This is a phenomenal amount of money and even beat the record amount that we raised last year.

We would like to say thank you to those who donated items for our stalls and raffle and to those who helped to organise and prepare for the day. Thank you to those who on the day helped to set up and tidy away and to those who volunteered on the stalls. And most importantly, thank you to all who attended and supported the event. We hope you enjoyed it as much as we did!

As communicated previously, Friends of Crossflatts have been raising funds for the new playground equipment in the KS1 playground. From money we raised last year and our events this year we had £6,087.92. VWG Mechanical, a local business who have links with two children in school, have very kindly donated £2,000 to this initiative leaving us with a total of £8,087.92. Therefore £2,382.08 of the money raised at Rose Day, will go towards the playground equipment and allow us to make a donation of £10,470 to school.


