

All Day, Every Day, The Crossflatts Way!


As you will be aware ensuring our children have very regular attendance is high on the national government agenda and the agenda of our local authority as well as on our school development plan. As a Bradford Council maintained school we follow Bradford Councils attendance strategy. There are only **190 days** in our school year and it is vitally important that all the children attend school every day, in order to gain the very most they can from the learning opportunities we provide at Crossflatts Primary School. The national target for attendance is **96%** and we are aiming to be above that target this year. In order to do so, we will be monitoring absences very closely and we are encouraging all our children to aim for at least **96%** attendance over the course of the year. Of course, we are all unwell from time to time and if there is a rare occasion your child is unwell and unable to come to school, please can I request that you telephone the school office to inform us of your child's absence no later than 8.30am. I also share your frustrations at the vast prices of holidays during school holiday periods however we are not able to authorise any holidays during school time and we have to adhere to the Bradford Council attendance strategy.
