- Book vending machine-Katy Sugden confirmed this will not include audio books as the CD's may be damaged when dropping out of the rows.

Planning for Spring Term activities (AI)

- Smarties tube To be handed out 11th February and returned to school 18th February-Money raised for the book vending machine project. It was agreed that we would pay for the machine to be branded with 'donated by Friends of Crossflatts' at the price of \$1500 rather than \$1250 non branded or decorated
- Amy Morgan suggested we could ask for donations of 'nearly new' books for the vending machine.
 There will be all age range books in the machine and it will take Julia Donaldson size books for younger readers.

- Green outdoor suits for Nursery 30x £35 = £1050 It was agreed that these would be bought for Nursery as
 existing ones are old and not waterproof any longer. The price is actually £778.50 due to a discount. To be
 paid asap.
- Grants + Local business update (AI) Claire Dyson looking into Tesco's grant but it will take approx.18
 months from the date of application to hear if have been successful. Plus, it needs to be linked to food distribution so not that relevant for a PTA activity. Could ask for PE equipment for 18 months time but at the moment better to ask local Crossflatts Tesco's with support for prizes for our competition's.
 - Kellogg's Breakfast Club grant sent to Katy Sugden to review but the school is not eligible to apply. More appropriate for inner city schools with higher number of disadvantaged families.

AOB (AII)

- Nicola Bennett suggested instead of traditional bake sale we have a Doughnut sale with doughnuts
 on a doughnut board. Mr Dobson could make a board that could be cleaned and sanitized before and
 after an event. This would be very easy to do and aligns with Natasha's law where we have to document all ingredients in baked products.
