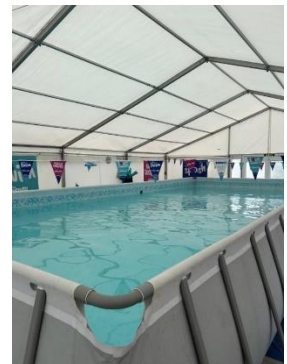

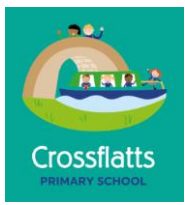
Thank you again to everyone that took part and supported our Decorate an Egg competition last term. We raised £60 which will go towards our on-going iPad fundraiser.
