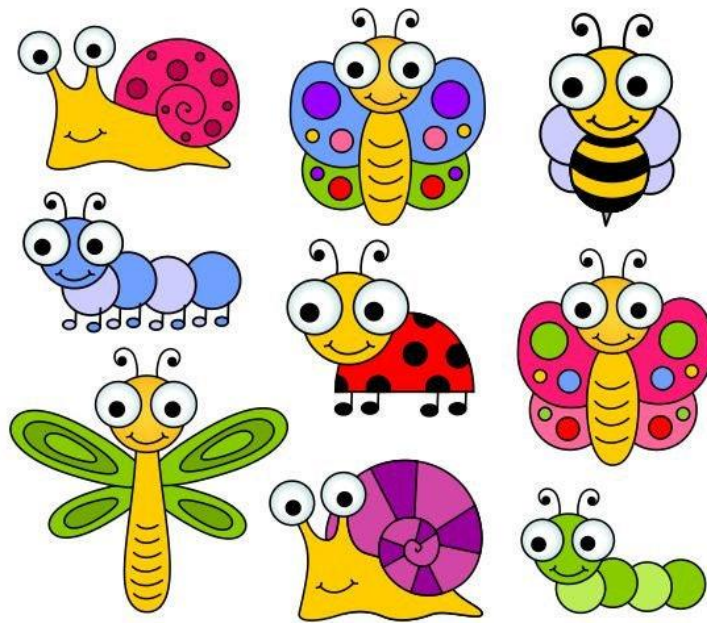

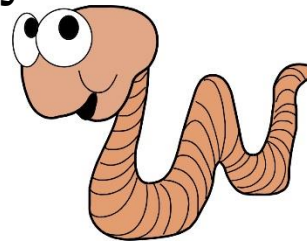

you can spot or draw?

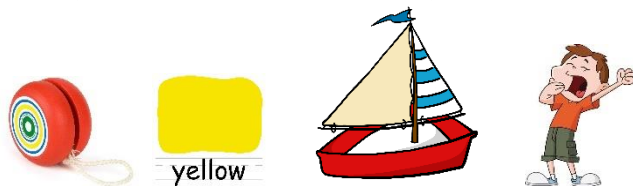


Sound of the week: y(yuh)

sound?

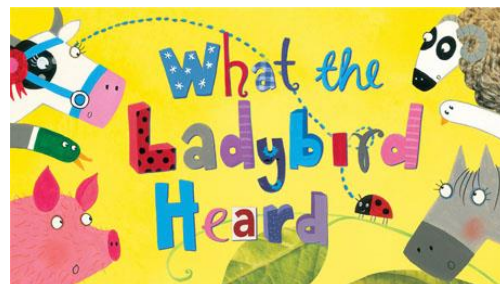
Say the words above and look into a
