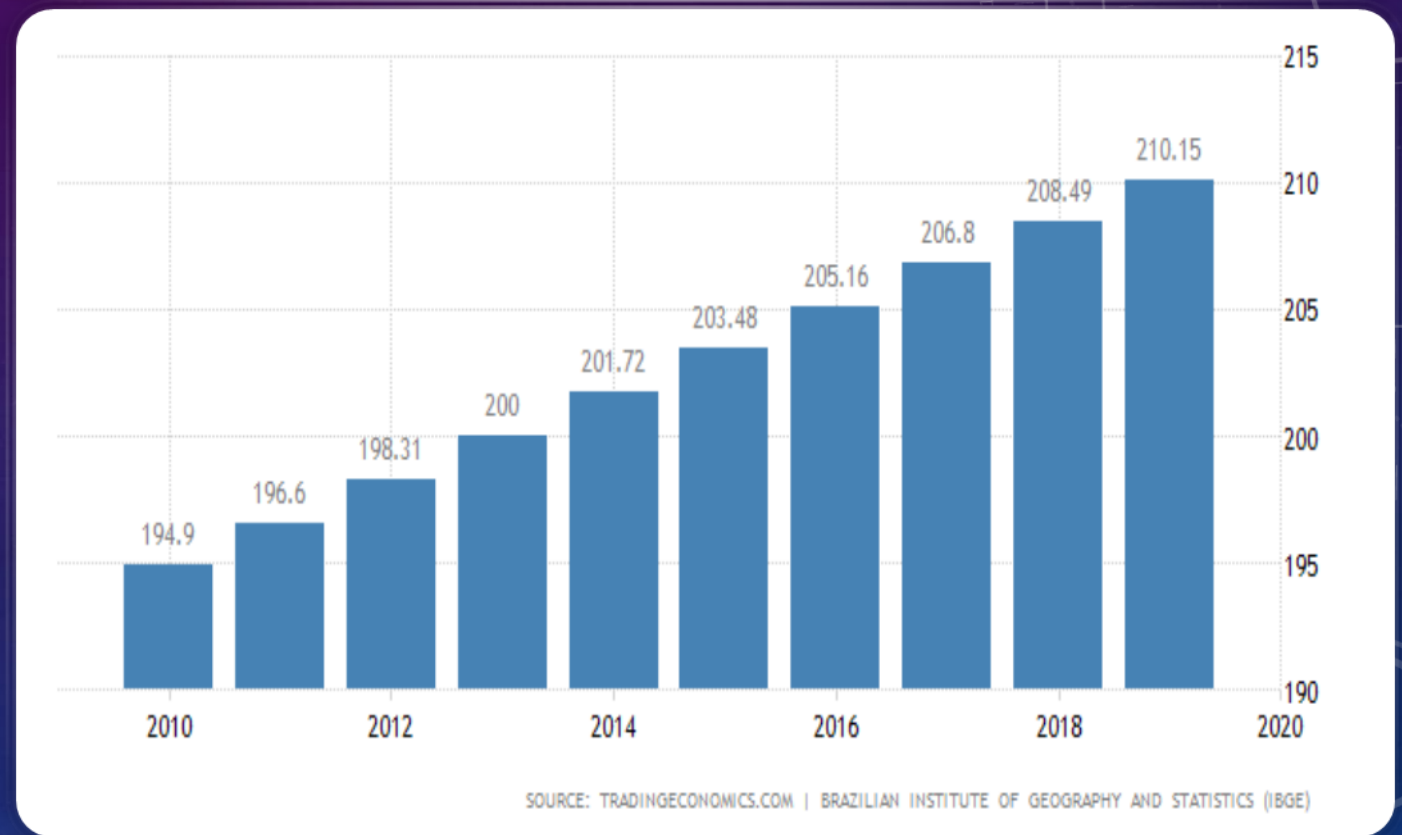
WHERE IS BRAZIL LOCATED?

BRAZILIAN WILDLIFE!



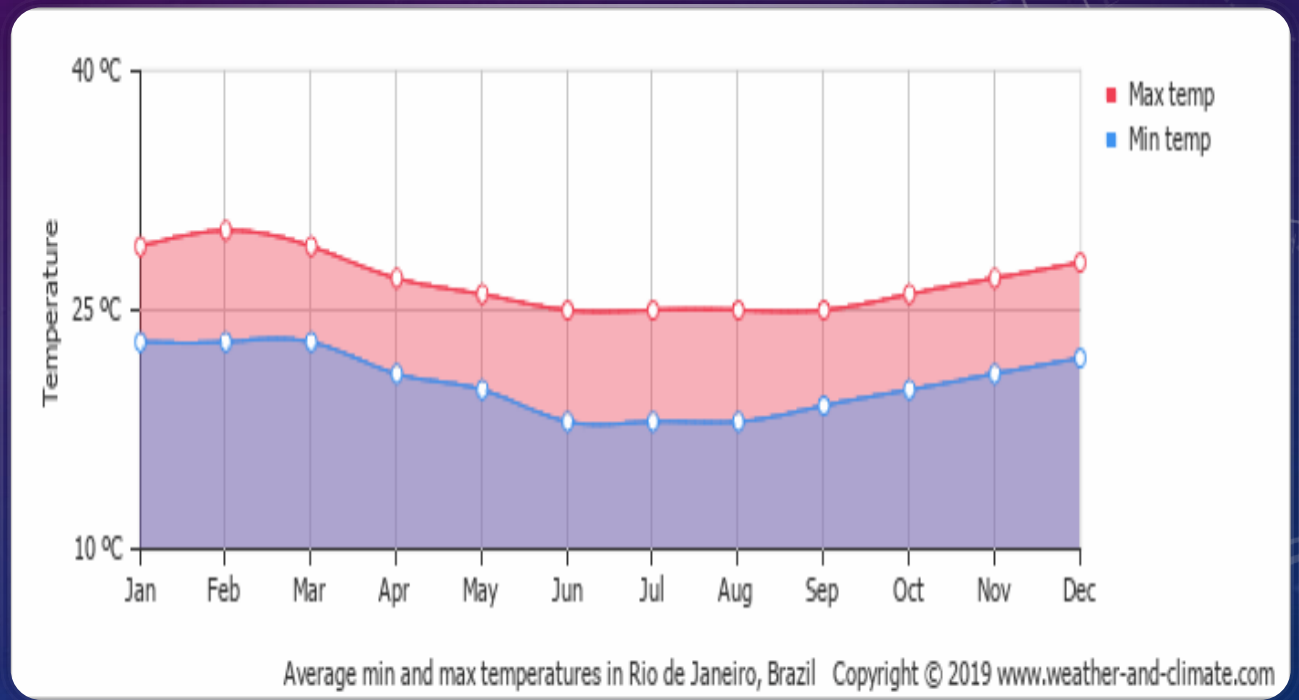
- GOLDEN LION TAMARIN – is a species found in south-eastern Brazil. Their faces are usually dark and hairless. An adult can be 10.3 inches in height and they weigh 620 grams.
- PIRHANA – this fish has very strong jaws and sharp teeth and are found in the amazon river.
- POISON DART FROG – is between 0.59 and 2.4 inches long. Their natural habitat in Brazil is freshwater marshes and swamps.
- YACARA CAIMAN – is a breed of crocodile. They grow between 6.6 and 8.2 feet long and can have a body weight of up to 58kg in males and 23 kg in females.

WHAT IS THE CLIMATE IN BRAZIL?

This graph shows the temperature of Rio de Janeiro, which is a well-known city. (the famous city in all of Brazil.)

The coldest months in Brazil are June, July and August.

The hottest months in Brazil are January, February and March.





WHAT IS BRAZIL FAMOUS FOR?

FOOTBALL! - Brazil has been crowned winner of the FIFA World Cup five times, more than any other country. Brazilians call soccer “Jogo Bonito”, Which means the “beautiful game” in Portuguese.



IGAZYU FALLS! – These are waterfalls of the Iguazu River. Together, they make up the largest waterfall in the world. The falls divide the river into the upper and lower Iguazu.

AMAZON RAINFOREST!

The majority (60%) of the amazon rainforest is in Brazil, but a small percentage of it overlaps into Peru and Columbia. It is the world's richest and most-varied biological reservoir, containing several million species. It is a scientists dream to explore all the nature. There are probably lots more species that live here that scientists haven't found yet.

This **amazing forest** is over 2.2 million square miles large and it is the largest tropical rainforest in the world. If you would lay the Amazon out over the United States, it would cover over half of it! **WOW!**



SOME POPULAR BRAZILIAN LANDMARKS!

CHRIST THE REDEEMER!

- You can't miss Christ the Redeemer in Rio de Janeiro. It's one of the iconic Brazil monuments and the most famous statue in the country.
- The grand statue of Jesus Christ sits at the top of the 700-metre-high Mount Corcovado in the Tijuca Forest National Park, towering over the city – an ever-present and striking feature on Rio de Janeiro's skyline.



The Lençóis Maranhenses National Park

- This is a vast area of white sand dunes, stretching over an area of roughly 1,500 km². For half of the year from January to June, the National Park witnesses torrential rainstorms. As a result, pools of rainwater collect in the valleys between the dunes and turn into thousands of beautiful blue, green and black lagoons that can reach over 90 metres long and 3 metres deep.
