Make a seaside mobile using twigs and string.





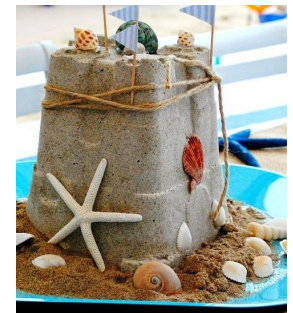
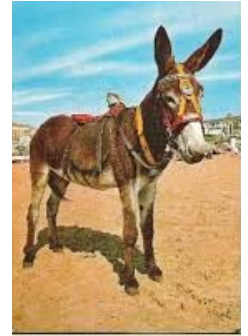
Hello Dragonflies and Bumblebees!
